This issue has been studied and testing has been performed and the lead exposure at a place like Portlnad International Raceway (PIR) is below OSHA limits during events allowing leaded gasoline. Further, there are three airports withing 15 miles of PIR that sell and allow planes to run avgas which also contains lead. The tests performed at PIR could not rule out that the lead measured was indeed from aircrafts and not vehicles racing at PIR.
