The information I have seen suggests that the exceedingly limited use of lead-containing fuels at Portland International Raceway is not a meaningful contributor to environmental issues in the area.

I support the continued move away from lead-containing fuels for motorsport, but this should be done by working with sanctioning bodies to phase them out, not by making Oregon's race venues incompatible with existing organizations. I live a few minutes from PIR, and that venue is very important to me. This legislation is somewhere between poorly conceived and a poorly veiled attack on PIR specifically, given the number of tracks fitting the description.
