students are able to focus on learning rather than on their next meal, they are more likely to succeed. Ensuring that all children have access to free, nutritious meals will enhance their well-being and provide every child the opportunity to thrive.

I urge you to support HB 3435 and ensure that every Oregon child has the food and nutrition they need to succeed in school.
