Studies are showing older individuals with untreated hearing loss can lead to cognitive decline or worse. Delay in accessing appropriate care is a disservice to this demographic and could have lasting consequences.

There is already a backlog of ones seeking help and not being able to be seen in a timely fashion. Removing qualified, professionally licensed hearing aid specialists from the equation will make it harder for ones seeking help with their hearing to have it addressed in a timely fashion.
