The golden goose is getting cooked!

Manzanita STR = 9% TIllamook STR = 10% ->14% State STR = 1/5% -> 2.5%

Total STR tax burden = 25.5% for Manzanita

Sounds great. A windfall!

But as a former business associate used to remind me: \$0 Revenue x 25.5% = ZERO!

People will take their hard earned dollars someplace else where they get better value. Stores, restaurants, services, all lose.

Cause in point: Portland has lost \$1Billion dollars of earned income from residents relocating because of tax increases and other issues. There is better value in other cities.

It's a great strategy to tax revenue sources that don't vote, but there is a limit. A cumulative 25.5% for Manzanita STR is probably at the breaking point.

Increased tax rates, but lower total revenue ahead, and loses of income for businesses with decreased visitors.
