The bill specifies the structure of the new Authority, including its Board of Directors, Staff and Budget. The new Authority would have the power to issue transmission revenue bonds, coordinate the implementation of GETs, streamline siting of new power facilities, and help establish public-private partnerships to enable robust funding. It's vital that this bill be passed as part of the package to meet Oregon's growing electricity demands in a safe, affordable, and sustainable way.
