I write to share my strong support for \$17.3 million in funding OAHP in the 2025 Oregon Legislative Session. OAHP helps Oregon leverage a remarkable 2:1 federal match through programs including the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) and protects working ranch and farmlands for their agriculture and natural resource values.

I have worked in agriculture for 50 years, as a farm worker milking cows, driving tractors, and harvesting vegetables; as a high school agriculture teacher; as a conservationist or the USDA-Natural Resources Conservation Service; as co-author of The Soils of Oregon reference book; as an elected director of a soil and water conservation district; and as the owner of a small agricultural consulting firm specializing in the improvement of soil on Oregon farms.
