The moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the Oregon Educators Benefit Board for the purpose of reimbursing districts for the cost of paying premiums for health benefit plans for substitute teachers under section 6 of this 2025 Act...."

"... SECTION 9. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Educators Benefit Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____, for deposit in the

Substitute Teacher Insurance Fund established under section 8 of this 2025 Act, for the purposes specified in section 6 of this 2025 Act..."

***The curse of "open-ended" GENERAL FUND budget allocation is the final "Kiss of Death (K.O.D.)" for this piece of Legislation.
