The only fiscal information is adding 5 more coalitions and ensuring that they are appropriately staffed. Do we know through outcomes that our present Health Equity Coalition are successful and or do they need additional funding to meet their target outcomes before we add new ones? What is the sustainability for existing and new coalitions? This is a challenge for me as I see the primary prevention field and other areas within the behavioral health work force grossly underfunded. I believe that Recovery High Schools may be on the chopping block which very well may impact many of the young people that desperately need that program.
