Without proper supports, many families end up having to place their children in out of home placements because they do not have the supports available to keep their children home with them. This leads to attachment issues, institutional trauma, and often times a path down the prison/institution pipeline for children who could have healed and thrived if their families would have been effectively resourced. The trauma impacts the entire family and creates even more mental health challenges. The medicaid entitlement has already been in place for the last 12 years, but it has not been utilized, even though we are witnessing an escalating mental health crisis in our child serving system. Families have been pleading for help and sharing their painful stories for long enough. Now it is time to act. This waiver is the right move because it focuses on prevention. Not only does this move the work upstream, but it saves the state money in the long run when families stay together, and children receive the critical supports they deserve in their homes, and in their communities.
