As a construction worker in Oregon, I have experienced how wage theft and labor exploitation drags down wages, hurts our communities and makes the construction industry so unattractive that it's turning away young people from careers in the trades.

The construction industry, particularly in the residential sector, is a well documented hotspot for abuse and exploitation. Under-the-table fraud and misclassification in construction is costing the state over \$112 million each year—money that could go toward supporting essential public services like schools, roads, and public safety.

If the State of Oregon is serious about protecting workers and putting an end to wage theft, we need to support SB 426, which will hold all market participants accountable for wage theft up and down the contracting chain.
