Thank you for the opportunity to submit testimony in support of HB 3628. This bill would establish the Oregon Electric Transmission Authority (OETA) as an independent public corporation.

Google is proud to call Oregon home. In addition to a growing Portland office, Google operates data centers in The Dalles. The construction and continued operation of these centers have brought valuable investments to Oregon. Along with these investments, Google has made a commitment to, by 2030, be powered with 24/7 carbon-free energy. To realize this future requires transmission capacity.

Creating a coordinated entity that will enable electricity generation projects to be connected to the grid, while being able to finance such infrastructure, will ensure Oregonians access new renewable energy resources, while keeping costs for all consumers down.
