Currently 90% of our total fuels in our state are based in one site, in a poorly maintained subduction zone near highly populated areas of our state and along a river that feeds into major shipping and commerce lines. We need to develop a plan to re-allocate resources in strategic areas of our state so that commerce and emergency response could go forward in the event of a disaster to the critical energy infrastructure hub.
