Re: <u>HB 2949</u> – Risk Bond Study – **Support**

LWVOR has strong positions on air quality, land use, water quality, protecting our coastal resources, public health, and climate change. LWVOR believes that all levels of government share the responsibility of coordinating, implementing and funding an effective program to mitigate Oregon's earthquake and tsunami hazards. Priority must be given to mitigation that protects human life and safeguards critical life-support systems. When siting critical facilities, seismic factors such as severe ground shaking, liquefaction, massive landslide potential, and subsidence should be considered. LWVOR has been working on seismic issues since 1995. In 2022, LWVOR endorsed SB 1567 as an initial step towards statewide energy infrastructure resilience and geographic diversity. Now LWVOR urges passage of HB 2949 as a next step towards achieving those critical goals.

By directing the Department of Energy to assess the potential for requiring owners of terminals located in the Critical Energy Infrastructure Hub to obtain risk bonds (i.e., financial assurance for costs associated with catastrophic releases after an earthquake), the bill opens an important pathway to make funds immediately available after an earthquake and to protect local taxpayers from the need to pay such costs when terminals are unable or unwilling to pay.

We urge your support for the Risk Bond Study bill.
