We need photo RADAR cameras in construction zones because the motoring public – both personal and commercial – just isn't paying attention. They are on their phones in constructions zones. They are not slowing down for construction zones. In fact, they are often substantially exceeding the basic rule through construction zones. For those wearing high resolution vests five or six days a week, it is disheartening, and dangerous.

I think we all acknowledge Oregon simply does not have enough Troopers, Deputies, and Officers to be detailed to the many construction zones across the state. So, a photo RADAR is our next best option. Perhaps are only other option.
