My husband and I urge you to reject House Bill 3103, which would force the Department of Forestry to log our public forests at unsustainable levels. This is short sighted and not what we expect our leaders to stand up to. DO NOT cave to the demands of timber executives seeking bigger profits. The State Forest HCP was developed with years of public input, and the courts have upheld Oregon's right to manage these forests for multiple benefits (County of Linn v. State of Oregon).
