My name is **Brook Anderson**, and I am **aspiring educator at University of Oregon studying to be a high school social studies teacher**. I am submitting this testimony in strong support of SB717, which seeks to address financial barriers for aspiring educators and ensure mentor teachers receive fair compensation.

I have yet to go into unpaid student teaching but I have a friend and coworker who is. She has told me struggles of exhaustion with having to take classes, work, and teach. It personally scares me, worried that I won't be able to live in Eugene and already expensive city to pay to live and have a job that benefits future Oregonians.
