6PPD-quinone is a toxic byproduct of 6PPD when exposed to ozone, a chemical that prevents tires from breaking down. 6PPD-quinone is lethal to coho salmon and other fish, among other species. Oregon has joined petition to EPA to restrict 6PPD, but aquatic screen values remain unenforceable. We need to address toxicity of tires and impacts to environment.
