The inability to bill for the services being provided in a new RTH until the DMAP is received, the delay in credentialing for qualified staff, and the drain on current resources due to the inability for clinicians to see clients for an extended time. System improvements are necessary for continued sustainability of behavioral health services in Oregon.
