Dear Chair Neron, Vice Chairs Dobson, and McIntire, and Members of the House Education Committee, I am writing this letter to express my support for House Bill 3037.

In the Prospect School District, we serve approximately 240 students in grades K-12. In my district, I am the District Superintendent and Elementary School Principal. Last year, our district was faced with the opportunity to apply for summer school funding. Due to the amount that we would have been awarded with our small ADW and tight timelines, we were faced with not applying for this funding. Unfortunately, most grant requirements and reporting are so extensive that many times, we do not apply or cannot find enough resources to complete such processes. House Bill 3037 would help set more meaningful grant funding floors for small districts like mine, and help alleviate the grant requirements – these changes are long overdue and will help reduce the time on paperwork, so that we can spend more time supporting students and staff.
