We utilize 16 apparatus to include 2 Fire Engines, 1 Ladder Truck, 4 ambulances, 5 Brush Trucks, 3 Tenders and 2 Command Trucks. Our tax income is projected to be approximately \$278,000.00 this year to include personnel, maintenance and operations. On our limited income, even a 4% increase for a tire tax is a financial burden.
