My name is Michael Valenti, and I am a middle school science teacher at Mt Tabor in Portland Public Schools. I am submitting this testimony in strong support of HB 3652, which would make class size and caseloads a mandatory subject of collective bargaining in all Oregon schools.

It is nearly impossible to meet the needs of all students in a science classroom with 35 kids. Despite all the tools we have been given, it is a daunting task and a disservice to all kids to be in classes this large. I am trying to get underperforming students up to benchmark while challenging talented and gifted students at the same time, and meet the needs of everyone in between.

I am in my 27th year of teaching in Portland and the job gets exponentially harder every year. I fear that educators will begin leaving the profession in larger numbers than we are already seeing, and there will be a shortage of incoming educators due to the lack of funding, under appreciation and large class sizes that we are facing.

I urge you to please support HB 3652 and its impact on students and educators.
