We have witnessed firsthand the devastating impacts of wildfires on homes, businesses, and critical infrastructure. This bill is an essential step toward mitigating wildfire risk and enhancing community resilience.

Wildfires are becoming more frequent and severe, posing a growing threat to both urban and rural communities across Oregon. Retrofitting homes and accessory structures with fire-resistant materials and designs is one of the most effective ways to improve survivability and reduce firefighting resource strain during major fire events. The City of Ashland is committed to supporting the construction of fire resistive homes as is evidenced through our adoption of R327.4 of the Oregon Residential Specialty Code throughout the city.

House Bill 3172 provides critical funding for:

- Retrofitting homes with ember-resistant vents, fire-resistant roofing, siding, and other proven protective measures.
- Prioritizing assistance to high-risk wildfire areas, socially vulnerable communities, and lowincome residents that may not have the financial means to retrofit their homes.
- Supporting homeowners whose properties have already been damaged or destroyed by wildfires.

By allocating resources to strengthen homes against wildfire, Oregon can help reduce overall suppression costs, improve firefighter safety, and most importantly, save lives. Proactive mitigation through retrofitting is a cost-effective approach compared to post-fire recovery, and we commend the Legislature for advancing solutions that prioritize resilience and preparedness.
