RE: Support for HB 3634 – Operator-in-Training and Water Workforce Program

Dear Chair Hudson, Co-Vice Chairs Fragala and Harbick, and members of the committee:

On behalf of the Regional Water Providers Consortium (Consortium), I am writing to express our <u>strong support for House Bill 3634</u>, establishing the Water Workforce Program to grow the supply of skilled water professionals.

The Consortium is comprised of 25 drinking water providers in the Portland, Oregon Metropolitan Area. The Consortium has been working collaboratively for 28 years to improve the planning and management of municipal water supplies in the region. Our members provide drinking water to over 1.6 million customers and operate 10 treatment plants, with two more coming on-line in the next couple of years.

Water providers are facing a staffing crisis as a large portion of our highly trained workforce is nearing retirement. Funding for operator-in-training apprenticeship programs will help water providers meet the challenges of recruiting and retaining a qualified workforce. Paid internship programs and expanding bilingual training opportunities to promote the workforce development of qualified drinking water and wastewater operators will also aid in these efforts.

HB 3634 fills an important gap in Oregon and will help ensure that our communities continue to have access to safe and clean water. As water providers we are happy to be a partner in these efforts.
