They are really more about recuperating funds for the insurer than they are actually looking out for the interests of the client. Therapists are frequently not taking insurance and trying to work from cash only basis (which only benefits clients who can afford that and leaves those who financially struggling behind) because they cannot afford to have money taken out for what are often arbitrary reasons - to unreasonable periods of time. Working with counselors to ensure standards are being met is of course acceptable, but having audits as a financial tool to strip us of earned income is not the way to achieve this goal.
