

Testimony on SB 784 Senate Education Committee March 10, 2025

Chair Frederick, Vice-Chair Weber, and members of the Committee. My name is Kyle Thomas, and I am the Director of Legislative and Policy Affairs for the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC). Thank you for the opportunity to submit testimony on SB 784. HECC has no position on the bill.

SB 784 does not change the existing statewide dual credit standards. Agriculture, forestry, and natural resources courses are already covered under current statute, which apply to all academic disciplines. These standards ensure consistency in course alignment, instructor qualifications, and assessment and other areas.

Since state standards already include these fields, SB 784 does not introduce new mandates, operational changes, or expand opportunities beyond what is currently available.
