My name is Sara Angeletti and have represented parents and children in family law matters in Oregon for over 20 years. I am writing to oppose SB 1130.

This proposed bill will have a chilling effect on protective parents, as well as limiting the discretion of the court. The bill is unnecessary. The court already has the authority to award make-up parenting time in whatever manner the court deems appropriate. Since family law cases are very fact-specific, requiring the court to take a certain action will lead to over-reach.

The bill should not be approved.
