Music champions have been working hard to fill the loopholes that still gave resale platforms room to grow. Here are the proposed adjustments.

Exempt Movie Theaters & Trade Shows – These events would not be subject to additional provisions in the bill.

Refine Anti-Bot Language – Adjust technical wording based on DOJ recommendations.

Remove Mandatory Reporting – Venue operators and ticket sellers would no longer be required to notify the Attorney General if banned software is detected.

Eliminate Forced Transferability – Remove subsection 4, which mandates that all tickets must be transferable.

Strengthen Upfront Pricing – Require a full pricing breakdown before consumers enter payment details.

Clarify Definitions – Update definitions of "base price" and "retail purchaser" for accuracy.

Adjust Fee Disclosure – Exempt delivery fees, government charges, and optional add-ons from upfront pricing requirements.

Musicians, music lovers, and venues - everyone except the people who contribute nothing to culture will be well served by passing the v3 version.
