My name is Keenan Moore, I live in Clackamas County, Oregon, and I am writing in strong support of HB 3193, the Farmworker Disaster Relief Fund.

Oregon's farmworkers play such a vital role in our society and economy, but because of their work, they are often the first to experience the impacts of extreme weather conditions. Research has shown that agricultural workers are 35 times more likely to die from heat-related stress than workers in other industries. Extreme heat and drought also are fueling more intense wildfire seasons, and outdoor workers are increasingly having to deal with harmful exposures to wildfire smoke and unhealthy air quality. With the effects of climate change accelerating, there is more reason to protect our vulnerable farmworkers.

HB 3193 will provide temporary financial relief to farmworkers in Oregon who lose work or wages due to extreme weather conditions. HB 3193 will define a "qualifying disaster" in regards to extreme weather as more than just extreme heat and smoke. This includes snow storms, ice storms, heavy raining, flooding, pandemics, etc. Conditions in which our farmworkers have continued working in despite the dangerous impacts to them physically and mentally.
