**Position on Bills at 2025
Session of Oregon Legislature:**

HB 3533: Support



The Consolidated Oregon Indivisible Network (COIN) is a coalition of over 50 local Indivisible groups throughout Oregon that cooperate and amplify their joint efforts to advance important federal and state legislation and engage with elected officials to promote causes for the benefit of all Oregonians.

COIN supports HB 3533, which would prohibit advertisements about consumer goods or consumer services for sale in Oregon from displaying in an advertisement or quoting during a transaction a price for the consumer goods or consumer services that does not include or disclose every fee that the consumer must pay to complete the sale of the consumer goods or consumer services. Violation of this requirement becomes an unlawful trade practice under the Unlawful Trade Practices Act.

Consumers are regularly ripped off by hidden fees. It is hard to believe that this practice is not already prohibited by Oregon law.
