On behalf of Multifamily NW, we are pleased to offer our strong support for SB 50, which amends the Local Innovation and Fast Track Housing Program Fund to direct the Housing and Community Services Department to allocate resources for the creation of affordable housing.

Multifamily NW is the largest association of housing providers in the state, representing nearly 300,000 units and every profession related to the industry — from property managers and owners to landscapers, maintenance professionals and screening companies. Our top priority is to collaborate with public sector leaders to identify and implement proven solutions to Oregon’s ongoing housing crisis.

The funding flexibility and strategic use of general obligation bonds will enable us to leverage these resources in a way that can have a real, lasting impact on Oregon's housing crisis.

SB 50 supports this approach by not only enhancing the resources available but also providing a clear directive to the Housing and Community Services Department to prioritize efforts that directly increase the supply of housing for those in need.
