## **Re: Support for House Bill 3145**

Dear Chair Marsh, Vice-Chairs Anderson and Breese-Iverson, and members of the House Committee On Housing and Homelessness:

Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony in support of House Bill 3145, which allows OHCS to use Local Innovation and Fast Track Housing Program Fund moneys for factory-built housing, requires the department to hire a contractor to support the factory-built housing industry, and requires the department to report on outcomes to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly.

Northwest Pilot Project (NWPP) is a social service agency with over five decades of experience in providing housing stabilization services to low and very low-income older adults, aged 55 and over, experiencing or at risk of homelessness in Multhomah County.

NWPP supports House Bill 3145, including the -1 amendment that details contract details if the bill passes. However, we encourage the Committee to consider two critically-important provisions that would support housing for older adults and people with disabilities:

- 1. Add language to Section 2(1)b that addresses the needs of "very low" and "extremely low" income households, in addition to "low" income households.
- In Section 2(4), add the following subsection so the department is able to give preference to funding housing is accessible: "Provides plumbing inserts that are compatible with accessible bathrooms and kitchens;"

With these two additions, this bill will help address housing precarity and homelessness faced by older adults and people with disabilities.
