Dear Senators on the Committee of Health Care,

I strongly oppose SB 1030 for the following reasons:

- It is yet another, unnecessary, over-reaching regulation on private businesses;
- I don't see in the bill who will pay for this directive. Since someone has to pay, it appears the taxpayers will suffer the cost or the residents themselves directly or through higher facility costs;
- The vaccine could cause more harm than good since people respond to vaccines differently. And, in fact, studies are showing that some vaccines can have a very negative effect on many more people than the vaccines are worth. The risk is greater than the benefit;
- No one is held liable for negative results of vaccines;
