The secretary of state should verify information provided to the secretary by the department of transportation, and the Oregon health authority regarding voter registration. This bill would prohibit the secretary from providing that voter registration information received from the Department of transportation, and the Oregon health authority to a county clerk, until and unless the secretary verifies that the voter is a United States citizen. This is a necessary step toward making elections credible and for the Secretary of State to earn back the trust of voters.

Complicating this issue was the Oregon legislature awarding illegal aliens the ability to obtain state driver's licenses, in defiance to Oregon voters overwhelmingly voting against this action. As if this slap in the face was not insulting enough, the legislature then approved the motor voter law that allows license holders to register to vote through the DMV.
