Position on Bills at 2025 Session of Oregon Legislature:

HB 3468: Support



The Oregon Progressive Party supports HB 3468, which would prohibit a county clerk from using information provided by the Secretary of State from the Department of Transportation or the Oregon Health Authority to change or update any voter registration information for an elector who is already registered to vote. The measure provides that an elector may update the elector's registration by delivering a completed registration card to specified officials or agencies or by completing a registration using the electronic voter registration system.

It appears to make sense to allow each registered voter to have control over the address associated with the person's voter registration. Visiting DMV or the Oregon Health Authority should not result in unexpected changes to a person's voter registration record. The process described by Vice-Chair Christine Drazen at the hearing sounds reasonable.
