- 1. Please accept my written testimony against HB2538. The bill needs several amendments and clarification. The verbiage in <u>Section 2</u> mandates Physicians and Physicians Associates (PA) shall take at least 2 hours every 6 years of continuing education regarding suicide risk assessment, treatment, and management as described in ORS 678.860 (line 8) that includes <u>lethal means</u> counseling as defined by the board. Lines 5 and 8 and need clarification.
- 2. On line 5 who makes up the board and makes the rules?
- 3. On line 8 what constitutes *lethal means*? Is *lethal means* assisted suicide? If *lethal means* is assisted suicide, then there needs to be a religious exemption for Physicians and PA's on line 8. Many faiths prohibit suicide. Line 8 has the appearance of assisted suicide not suicide prevention.
