- a. <u>Amend Section 1 -2.</u> The program should have Oregon Department of Veterans (ODVA) for eligibility.
- b. Amend <u>Section 1-2 (line 8)</u> Is the Veterans Waiver Program in lieu of any Veterans Administration (VA) medical care? Would VA eligible veterans not qualify?
- c. <u>Amend Section 1 -4 to add ODVA</u> (they should be included since they know the VA healthcare rules/guidelines and know the rules who is ineligible for VA Healthcare
- d. Amend Section 1 -4-A line 19 to add *to income eligibility* Federal and State Income Tax Return.
- e. <u>Amend Section 1 -4-B line 21</u> to add to DD form 214 *Discharge Papers and Separation Documents and* DD 215 *Correction Form.*
