4D Recovery **strongly supports HB 2270** for the following reasons:

- **Increased Medicaid Reimbursement Rates** – Raising reimbursement rates for **Board-Certified Addiction Medicine and Addiction Psychiatry Physicians** is essential for sustaining current services and expanding access to critical care.
- **Ongoing Rate Review** – Establishing a task force to **regularly review reimbursement rates** will ensure that funding aligns with actual costs, supporting long-term service sustainability.
- **Technical Assistance for Expansion** – Providing **technical assistance** is key to increasing the number of professionals utilizing Medicaid for addiction treatment, ultimately improving access for those in need.
- **Enhanced Coordination & Efficiency** – Centering the **Alcohol and Drug Policy Commission** in this work will **reduce silos** across agencies and **streamline government efforts** to address substance use disorder (SUD) treatment.
