My name is Bret Frauendiener. I am life long Oregon resident and Medically Retired Deputy Sheriff. My biggest issue is the guilty until proven innocent provision on this bill. When Measure 114 was originally found to violate the Oregon Constitution, it never went into effect. It was still legal to purchase magazines that held more than 10 rounds. This bill would make it a crime for anyone who purchased one of these magazines, when it was still legal to do so.

This goes against the fabric of the State and Federal Constitutions, where the burden of proof lies on proving innocence. This is especially true, since there was no law signed into effect, that would have prohibited the purchase in the first place.

I would simply ask, to grandfather those already in possession of magazines to be

grandfathered in. Then set a date where they can no longer be purchased, after the law is signed into effect. This is what Washington and other states have done. Not to mention this would be next to impossible to prove and would burden our court system with citizens who technically did nothing wrong, as again, there was no law signed to prevent it.
