The charter middle school our oldest child attends offers an amazing environment, flexibility in learning, passionate staff and students, student autonomy and project driven learning, and our child still does very well on state tests and gets great grades. In a given day, our child practices pre-algebra, language arts, science, social studies, farming, caring for animals, art, participating in music, sometimes cooking, community volunteering, among many other pursuits. This fosters an autonomy, engagement, and leadership in our child that was not present at other schools. My child is having a middle school experience I would have dreamed of. But this wonderful school is underfunded, as all Oregon public charter schools are. Unfortunately, the students, staff, and families pay the price. As more families are choosing charter school education for their families in an evolving/shifting education model, the importance of equalizing charter school funding is more important than ever before. By passing HB 3444, we can fix this ongoing disparity and provide fair funding for public charter school students who deeply need it. Please vote yes on HB 3444.
