The creation of this bill was an overreaching and unnecessary action. The crimes listed are severe crimes whether occurring at the specified infrastructural systems or anywhere else. Increasing the severity of the label associated with these crimes to "domestic terrorism" is overkill, especially when considering the uncertain and concerning actions of our current administration. On the basis that this bill's existence is not to true benefit of the people, I am in opposition of expanding it in any way, including a simple amendment to what qualifies as "critical infrastructure". This is an unnecessary move which has a greater likelihood of being applied to activists and protestors than it does to terrorists.
