Dear Mr. Broadman,

I am writing to urge your support for increased funding for Regional Inclusive Services for K-12 Special Education in the upcoming budget. As the Superintendent of the High Desert Education Service District (HDESD), I work closely with our regional school districts to provide essential services for students with disabilities. However, as districts across Central Oregon face significant budget reductions, the ability to provide Free and Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) for our most vulnerable students is increasingly at risk.

Regional Inclusive Services play a critical role in ensuring that students with disabilities receive the specialized support they need to thrive. I appreciate your leadership and commitment to ensuring all students receive a highquality education. I would welcome the opportunity to discuss this issue further and provide any additional information that would be helpful as you consider this urgent need.
