I oppose both this bill and Measure 114 completely. I was never a firearms owner until Measure 114 narrowly passed in 2022. Since then I'm a lawful firearms owner who went through the required background checks and have taken classes to further my skills as a safe and competent firearms owner. To require Permit to Purchase is in direct violation of the Bill of Rights. Unlawfully "converting a right into a privilege/license is unconstitutional" (Murdock v. Pennsylvania 319 US 105).
