Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB3075

I am an Oregon voter, and I support HB3075-1. Please pass HB 3075-1 for full implementation of Measure 114 before more people die of gun violence. My brother, aunt and cousin all died from gun violence. I do not want others to suffer this unnecessary kind of grief. We have more guns than people in the USA.
