As a senior citizen of the state of Oregon I am adamantly opposed to House Bill 3075. This bill does nothing to improve or address public safety. Rather it infringes on the rights of lawful firearms owners. It is unreasonably burdensome with no mechanism to purchase or possess firearms and firearms related equipment that complies with all Federal Firearms laws, which are protected by the 2nd Amendment of the US constitution.
