Dear Legislators,

I have been volunteering full time with <u>Vision Quilt</u> since 2016 to create a safe Oregon. I have met with hundreds of families and youth including gun owners, veterans, previously incarcerated individuals and survivors. They all want safe neighborhoods and schools. I support HB3075 Measure 114 because it will help create that safety. The facts are:

- Less than 2% of Oregon's 2,000 gun dealers were inspected last year even though nearly half of inspections show significant violations like selling guns without background checks or failing to report multiple sales.
- Over **6,000 illegal guns** were recovered in Oregon last year, and nearly **75%** were traced back to Oregon gun dealers.
- States with gun dealer licensing have reduced gun trafficking by **70%** and gun homicides by **36%**.
- Nearly every other industry from taco trucks to nail salons is required to meet basic business standards and inspections. It's time to hold gun dealers to the same level of accountability.
