

Dear Legislators,

I have been volunteering full time with [Vision Quilt](#) since 2016 to create a safe Oregon. I have met with hundreds of families and youth including gun owners, veterans, previously incarcerated individuals and survivors. They all want safe neighborhoods and schools. I support HB3075 Measure 114 because it will help create that safety. The facts are:

- Less than **2% of Oregon's 2,000 gun dealers** were inspected last year — even though nearly **half of inspections** show significant violations like selling guns without background checks or failing to report multiple sales.
- Over **6,000 illegal guns** were recovered in Oregon last year, and nearly **75%** were traced back to Oregon gun dealers.
- States with gun dealer licensing have reduced gun trafficking by **70%** and gun homicides by **36%**.
- Nearly every other industry — from taco trucks to nail salons — is required to meet basic business standards and inspections. It's time to hold gun dealers to the same level of accountability.
