My name is Michael Halverson, I'm a concerned Oregon resident, and I'm writing to you and submitting this testimony in opposition to HB 3075. The way that this bill is currently structured and the changes it makes to 114, have me extremely concerned about my personal liberties and those of my fellow Oregonians. For example;

The price of the permit to purchase is being increased, and that adds a significant barrier to persons of lower income status, who may attempt to acquire a firearm for defense in the home, which is of greater need to those in lower income areas.

It also increases the wait time from 30 to 60 days, which could be valuable time lost of a person is in fear of bodily harm, and needs to acquire a means of selfdefense.

These modifications to 114 will only hurt those who are less economically fortunate, and those for whom time is is critically important. None of whats here will make 114 better for Oregonians, but instead make it even more burdensome.
