Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB3075

HB 3075 makes it harder and more expensive for people to get a gun permit, especially affecting low-income individuals. It also limits where people can challenge the law, which feels unfair. The bill skips normal public input by declaring an emergency, raising concerns about transparency. While some groups, like law enforcement, get exceptions, others don't—making the law feel unequal. Lastly, it changes a previous measure that's still being debated in court, which seems premature.
