Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB3075

I am an Oregon voter who collected signatures to get Measure 114 on the ballot. It's now been almost 2.5 years since the Measure's passage. Since then, both the Federal District court and the Oregon Court of Appeals have carefully considered the Measure and have upheld its constitutionality. Oregon's citizens should not have to wait any longer than necessary for the Measure to take effect. That is why I strongly support HB 3075-1.
